Working with community organizations that have purchased vacant properties, RTP not only brings the dilapidated structures to code, but guarantees its work for two years. This partnership produces affordable housing, especially for first-time home buyers.

A win-win for communities and homebuyers

RTP's first transformative Rehab for Resale project was with the Hazelwood initiative. The rundown house was renovated and sold to a low- to moderate-income family in 2015 for \$70,000—twice the average sales price in Hazelwood that year.
